CA AB 1532 Lieu (D)	<p>Code Enforcement Officers</p> <p>Amends existing law that defines the term code enforcement officer for purposes of determining the punishment for assault and battery committed against such officer. CA AB 1693 Ma (D)	<p>Building Standards: Code Adoption Cycle</p> <p>Amends the Building Standards Law. Modifies and extends the code adoption cycle. CA AB 1746 Emmerson (R)	<p>Architects: Continuing Education</p> <p>Authorizes the Architects Board to audit a licensee's records. Requires the board to audit at least 3% of the licensee renewals received each year to verify completion of the coursework. Requires a licensee to provide the specified documentation only upon that audit. Exempts a licensee from certain coursework requirements for the licensee's first renewal under certain circumstances. <p>CA AB 2561 Villines (R)</p>	<p>Energy: Energy Commission and Department Transfers various energy related powers, duties, responsibilities, obligations, liabilities, and jurisdiction to, from, and between specified existing and newly created energy planning and conservation agencies and boards. Repeals the Katz Safe Schoolbus Clean Fuel Efficiency Demonstration Program, the Small Business Energy Efficient Refrigeration Program, the State Solar Medallion Passive Design Competition and the Consumer Power and Conservation Financing Authority Act.</p>	<p>08/02/2010:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In SENATE.
